ACCEPTABLE USE POLICY – COMPUTERS AND NETWORK

Parents and students should read and sign the following together.

Use of Triple C School's computers and the Internet is a privilege granted to students. The Internet provides a wealth of resources, information and educational opportunities. The following is a list of expectations we have for the students and the consequences should they not meet them. Before a student is allowed to use the school's computers and access the Internet through the school's network, this policy must be signed and returned to the school office. **Once signed, this contract is valid until the student either graduates or permanently withdraws from Triple C School.**

1. Students will only be allowed on the Internet with permission from a teacher. Students are not allowed to use any computer or access the Internet without a teacher present.
2. Students will only be allowed online if a signed Acceptable Use Policy is on file.
3. Students may print information but should not plagiarize, as this is dishonest and illegal. There is a charge of C\$0.10 per page for all materials copied or printed.
4. Students are not allowed to interact with "live" sites, i.e. checking email, entering chat rooms, playing 'live' games, joining news groups, etc. This is for the students' protection.
5. Students are not allowed to seek out or sign on to sites on the Internet that may have inappropriate material. Sites that are considered inappropriate include, but are not limited to sites about secular music, pornography, the occult, astrology, or any site deemed inappropriate by the staff of Triple C School.
6. Students will not change the settings on the computer or load any software without the supervising teacher's permission.
7. Students will not subscribe to sites, online contests, or online offers using the school's computers.
8. Students will not divulge personal information about themselves, about others or about the school while online.
9. Students will not place orders for products information, catalogs, or products online using the school's computers.
10. Students will not use any of the email accounts owned by the school for personal email traffic.
11. Triple C School reserves the right to review any material stored in files to which all users have access and will edit or remove any material which the staff, in its sole discretion, believes may be unlawful or conveys anything of an offensive nature.
12. That there is no expectation of privacy for any individual who sends, receives, or stores information via the Triple C School network.
13. All information services and features on the Triple C School network are intended for educational use and any commercial or unauthorized use of those materials or services, in any form, is expressly forbidden.

We have read the Acceptable Use Policy and agree to abide by the terms set out in it **OR** I do not wish my child to participate.

Failing to abide by the terms of this agreement will result in loss of computer privileges for one day up to a year. There could also be further disciplinary action taken depending on the severity of the act.
