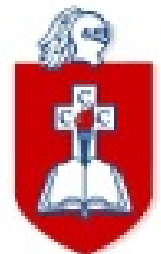

Preparation Steps for COVID -19



1. Early Childhood (ECE), Primary, Middle, and High School classes have hand sanitizer in their classrooms and in their common areas.
2. The school nurse has demonstrated proper hand washing to ECE and Primary students. Posters showing the proper hand washing procedures are in all bathrooms and in the infirmary.
3. Hand Sanitizer dispensers are in the Office, Infirmary, Library, Canteen, Home Economics, Art and Science classrooms.
4. The Parent Teacher Association (PTA) has ordered hand sanitizer dispensers from Island Supply.

RESPONSE PLAN: The following plans will be adhered to prevent transmission of COVID –19



PLAN A: This plan will be initiated when/if COVID-19 spreads to the Caribbean region and significant in-country transmissions are identified.

Custodial Workers will continue to clean and disinfect designated classrooms and common areas.

Administrators and teachers will view the accrediting agency’s Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI) website on Thursday, March 12th, in preparation for distance learning lessons and assignments.

Plan B: If/When COVID-19 Official Declared

Begin ‘Social Distancing’ by cancelling all parent/reporting events, large group gatherings, etc.

Incorporate advise from Accrediting Agencies with regards to assignments/quizzes/exams/projects and share with parents and students



Plan C: This plan will be activated if/when the Health Service Authority or the Cayman Islands Government instructs schools to close or a seminal event occurs to any person in attendance at the school

School is closed with further advice given by the CAO and Vice Principals.

Teachers to continue to develop lesson plans and develop distance learning

Usage of WhatsApp by administrators, faculty and staff.



Plan D: This plan begins when schools are re-opened.

Schools are reconvened with measured responses taken as appropriate and directed by the Ministry of Health and the Ministry of Education.

Appropriate remedial response agreed and shared with regards to any lost learning. This may include a restructuring of the academic year to recover lost instructional time.

This initial plan will be reviewed and modified as new information and guidelines become available.
