**Vision Statement:**

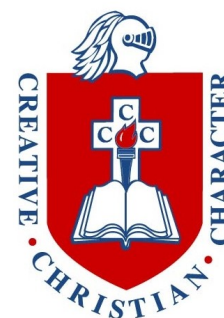

**ABC's of Prevention:****Act It**

**Triple C School is taking a proactive approach to COVID 19.****This includes:**

- **Creation of a COVID 19 Committee**
- **Teacher/Student training and drilling on response steps**
- **Teacher/Student training in online teaching formats**
- **Monitoring of temperatures, sanitizing, and social distancing**
- **Grouping students for possible staggered in-school/home-based format.**

## Preparation Steps for COVID -19



1. Early Childhood (ECE), Primary, Middle, and High School classes have hand sanitizer bottles in their classrooms and in their common areas.
2. The school nurse demonstrates proper hand washing to ECE and Primary students. Posters showing the proper hand washing procedures are in all bathrooms.
3. Hand sanitizer dispensers are in the Office, hallways, Infirmary, Library, Canteen, Home Economics, Art, and Science classrooms.
4. Daily temperature checks are completed upon arrival (students & staff).

## RESPONSE PLANS

### Plans to prevent transmission of COVID - 19



#### **PLAN A:** This plan will be initiated if/when the Health Services Authority announces an active community case of COVID - 19

- Custodial workers will clean and disinfect common areas; teachers will disinfect desk surfaces between classes
- Daily temperature checks will be conducted upon arrival (students, staff & parents/guardians) before entering buildings
- Monitored hand sanitizing before entering classrooms, & canteen
- Masks worn at the discretion of students' parents

#### **PLAN B:** If/When the Health Services Authority notifies that cases appear to be spreading.

- In-person attendance reduced to 50% schoolwide (50% online at home)
- Building entry restricted to students, staff, and parents/guardians
- No visitors allowed entry; parents/guardians limited access
- Begin Social Distancing by cancelling all events and large group gatherings
- Masks required of everyone in the building and on the campus
- Temperature checks of anyone entering the building
- Social distancing and hand sanitizing monitored



#### **PLAN C:** This plan will be activated if/when the Health Services Authority of the or the C.I. Government instructs schools to close or if a seminal event occurs involving any person in attendance at the school within prior 14 days.



- School is closed with further advice given by the Principal/CAO and Vice Principals
- Administrators, faculty and staff communicate via WhatsApp groups and/or email
- Online teaching mode is activated, requiring teachers to provide instruction utilizing Zoom, FACTS, See Saw (Elementary), IXL & Google Classroom platforms

**PLAN D: This plan begins when schools are re-opened.**

School reconvenes with measured responses taken as appropriate and directed by the Ministry of Health and the Ministry of Education.

Assessment of any lost-learning and remedial plans implemented. This may include a restructuring of the academic year to recover lost instructional time.

**Plan Review:**

This plan will be reviewed and modified as new information and guidelines become available.
